

16 to 19 tuition fund

The college is pleased to announce that in line with additional funding provided by the Education and Skills Funding Agency for academic year 20/21 we will be offering small group support tuition for all our eligible 16-19 students. This funding will be prioritised for disadvantaged students.

The purpose of the fund is to support small group tuition for maths, English or in other courses where learning has been disrupted due to COVID-19.

Please note that in order to be eligible to access the fund a student must be between 16-19, on a Programme of Study and have achieved a 4 or below on their maths and English GCSE grade at age 16. Learners who have a 5 or above in both these subjects will not unfortunately be eligible. Young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) aged 19 to 24 who have an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan will be eligible for support via the 16 to 19 Tuition Fund.

Funding will be used to support tuition activity above and beyond the programmes of education already planned for this academic year. Eligible learners will have identified slots on their timetables with the code of TCC (Tutorial for Covid Catch Up). These slots are a scheduled timetabled event that will provide small group tuition to disadvantaged learners who would benefit from additional support and teaching. These sessions will be subject to the usual audit requirements and fall under the quality assurance systems of the college.
