Summary

Early years Educator and other job roles such as nursery nurse and childminders are highly trained professionals. They play a key role in ensuring that young children learn and

develop well and are kept healthy and safe. They work in a range of settings including full day care, children's centres, pre-schools and reception classes. Individuals will undergo all the checks as per the EYFS requirements to ensure suitability to work with children

Entry Criteria

We would expect apprentices to have GCSE's Grades 9-3 (A-D) in Maths and Grades 9-4 (A-C) in English

Attendance

Apprentices will attend college one day a week (during term-time only)

Duration

18 months + End Point Assessment

What will I learn?

You will study towards a level 3 Early years Educator qualification.
Apprentices must also successfully complete the level 3 award in Paediatric First Aid as part of the Apprenticeship.

- Planning, observation and assessment
- Promote child development
- Plan, lead and review play opportunities
- Developing children's skills
