Summary

Geospatial Survey Technicians collect geospatial data (data relating to geographic position on the earths' surface) for the use in the creation of maps, satellite navigation systems, Global Positioning Systems (GPS) construction of infrastructure including roads, buildings, bridges, offshore construction such as wind turbines and oil rigs, the identification of local, suburban or international boundaries, military, mining and a wide range of other purposes. Geospatial Technicians use a wide range of technologies such as Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and electronic data capture tools and processes, such as Building Information Modelling

Entry Criteria

We would expect apprentices to have achieved 5 GCSE's Grades (9-4) or (A-C) including Maths and English.

Attendance

Apprentices will attend college one day a week (during term-time only) at our Cronton College campus.
