Level 2 Bricklayer Apprenticeship

Summary

Bricklayers lay bricks, blocks and other types of building components in mortar to construct and repair walls, foundations, partitions, arches and other structures e.g. chimney stacks. They might also refurbish brickwork and masonry on restoration projects. The range of sites and projects that bricklayers will work on include large commercial developments, new builds in housing, alterations, extensions and restorations.

Entry Criteria

We would expect apprentices to have achieved 4 GCSEs including Maths and English at grade 3/D.

Attendance

Apprentices will attend college one day a week (during term-time only) at our Riverside College campus.

Duration

24 months + EPA

What will I learn?

On the level 2 Bricklayer apprenticeship, you will gain the necessary knowledge, skills and behaviours to become a proficient bricklayer. Training will include:

- Health, safety and welfare in construction
- Principles of building construction, information and communication
- Building cavity walls and complex masonry structures
- Building solid walling, isolated and attached piers
- Interpreting working drawings to set out masonry structures

On completion of this Apprenticeship, you will have satisfied the requirements to obtain a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) Card at the appropriate level
