Summary

Commencing an apprenticeship within the Health and Social Care industry will provide you with the opportunity to gain significant job-satisfaction from the positive impact that you are having on your community. As an adult care worker, you will be providing essential frontline care for vulnerable adults within their own homes, day care centres, residential and nursing homes and other healthcare settings.

Apprentices will also need to undertake the Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service process and provide the result prior to starting.

On the level 2 Adult Care Worker Apprenticeship, you will gain the necessary knowledge, skills and behaviours to become a proficient adult care worker. As part of your apprenticeship, part of your time will be spent doing 'off the job' training which will include:

- Relevant statutory standards and codes of practice for their role
- How to contribute towards the development and creation of a care plan
- The tasks and responsibilities of the job role relevant to the context of the service in which they are working.
- How to identify, respond to and escalate changes to physical, social, and emotional needs of individuals
- The importance of communication
- How to support individuals to remain safe from harm (Safeguarding)
- Championing health and wellbeing for the individuals they support and for work colleagues
