Engineering and Manufacturing Support Technician Apprenticeship

Summary

On the Level 3 Engineering and manufacturing support technician Apprenticeship you will cover all areas of this role, which supports the work of engineers by the provision of technical support and expertise for areas of the engineering and manufacturing function. This typically could include, engineering drawing, computer aided design (CAD), quality control, computerized numerical control programming (CNC), robotics, additive manufacturing, engineering or manufacturing software development and process engineering.

Entry Criteria

4 GCSEs at grade C/4 including Maths and English.

Attendance

Apprentices will attend college one day a week (during term-time only) at our Riverside College campus.

Duration

42 months + EPA

Gateway (42 months+)

- Content that apprentice is occupationally competent
- Level 2 Maths/English
 - Sufficient portfolio

Your End Point Assessment



End Point Assessment (42—45 months)

- Completed over a 3 month period to allow for work scheduling
- Distinction / Pass / Fail marking

Assessment Type

- Portfolio of evidence
- Work based report with presentation and questioning
