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Summary

Commencing an apprenticeship within the Health and Social Care industry will provide you with the opportunity to gain significant job-satisfaction from the positive impact that you are having on the individuals that you are supporting. As a senior healthcare support worker, you will be providing high-quality and compassionate care to the individuals you are supporting.

Entry Criteria

There is no formal entry criteria for this apprenticeship however we would expect to see:

- Apprentices to have achieved or be able to demonstrate the ability to work towards level 2 for English and Maths.
- Apprentices at this level would also be expected to have a relevant level 2 qualification or equivalent industry experience and be in a lead role.
- Apprentices on the Level 3 Senior Healthcare Support Worker Apprenticeship will need to be in an allied healthcare professional role and trained in undertaking clinical observations.
- Apprentices will also need to have undertake a DBS.

- Level 2 Maths/English
- Portfolio
