Electrical Installation Apprenticeship

Summary

Installation Electricians are trusted to install, test, understand and apply the principles of planning and selection for installing electrotechnical equipment and systems in buildings, structures and the environment. On the Electrical Installation apprenticeship, learners will start at the foundation level and work upwards to complex skills and knowledge. Following completion of this apprenticeship, learners will complete the AM2S test as part of their end point assessment and will become qualified installation electricians.

Entry Criteria

We would expect apprentices to have achieved 4 GCSEs including Maths and English at grade 4/C.

Attendance

Apprentices will attend college one day a week (during term-time only) at our Riverside College campus.

Duration

42 months + EPA

What will I learn?

On the Level 3 Installation Electrician apprenticeship, you will gain essential knowledge, skills and behaviours. Training will include how to:

- Apply health and safety and environmental considerations
- Plan and oversee electrical work activity
- Understand termination and connection of conductors
- Understand inspection, testing and commissioning
- Understand and apply fault diagnosis and rectification
- Understanding electrical principles and technologies
- Understand requirements of electrical installations
- Apply/Understand design, Installation and maintenance procedures
- Organise and oversee the electrical work environment
- Terminate and connect conductors
- Inspect, test and commission electrical systems
