Summary

Commencing an apprenticeship within the Health and Social Care industry will provide you with the opportunity to gain significant job-satisfaction from the positive impact that you are having on your community. As a lead adult care worker, you will be leading essential frontline care for vulnerable adults within their own homes, day care centres, residential and nursing homes and other healthcare settings.

Entry Criteria

There is no formal entry criteria for this apprenticeship however we would expect to see all apprentices to have achieved or to demonstrate the ability to work towards level 2 for English and Maths. Apprentices at this level would also be expected to have a relevant level 2 qualification or equivalent industry experience and be in a lead role. Apprentices will also need to undertake the Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service process and provide the result prior to starting.

What will I learn?

As part of your apprenticeship, 20% of your time will be spent doing 'off the job' training. Training will include:

- Relevant statutory standards and codes of practice
- How to create a care plan/monitor and review a care plan in response to changing needs
- Implement the assessment of social, physical, emotional and spiritual needs of individuals with cognitive, sensory and physical impairments
- Guide/contribute to the development of colleagues in the execution of their duties
- How to lead and support others
- The tasks/responsibilities of the job role relevant to the context of the service
- How to respond to and escalate changes to the needs of individuals
- How to support individuals to remain safe from harm (Safeguarding)
- Lead/support others to address conflicts or dilemmas that may arise between an individual's rights and duty of care
- Championing health and wellbeing for individuals/work colleagues
