Welcome to Riverside College- Here is everything you need to know about a “bubble”

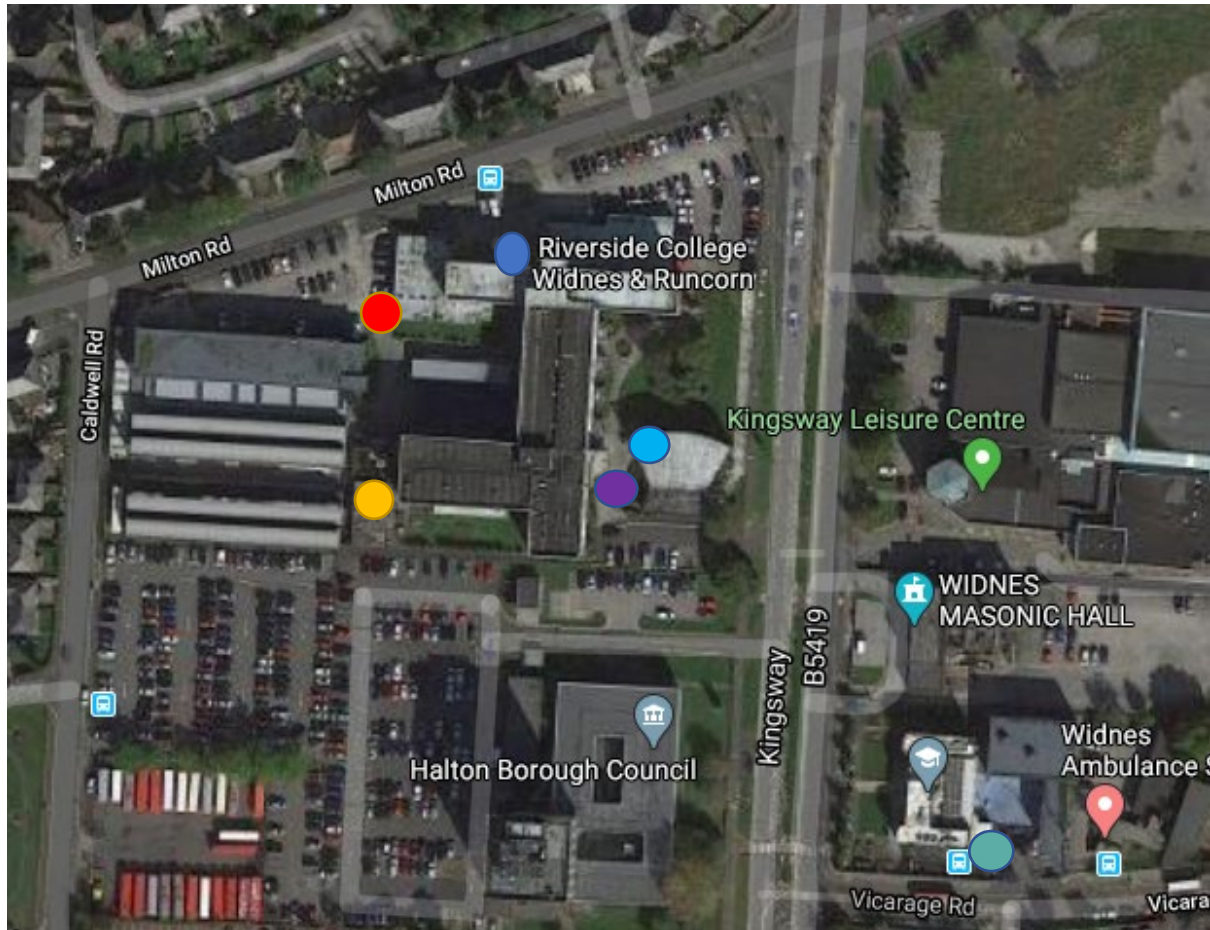
A “Bubble” helps control the spread of Covid-19 by minimising contact and the unnecessary mixing of people. It also means if a positive case of Covid-19 should be identified that smaller groups of staff and students will be required to self-isolate rather than the entire college or site.

We will of course still be maintaining distancing guidelines within your “bubble”, but the key idea is to reduce the number of contacts you are exposed to. Each bubble will be colour coded. Please stay within your bubble where possible. Lanyards will be used to help quickly identify who is meant to be in each bubble, please help us by keeping within your bubble and wearing your lanyard.
